- 2. The placement of the Historic Marker and the new Pine tree was discussed.
- 3. The Marker was placed at the northwest side of the parking lot. The Pine tree will be placed 3 or 4 feet behind the marker at a later date.
- 4. It was decided that Jim will order 25 metal grave markers from W. F. Norman Corporation.
- 5. The chain link fence will be on hold until more money comes in.
- 6. It was decided to wait one year to see if the fire damaged trees will recover or be removed.
- 7. The fire damaged Apple tree and all wire, brush and lilacs were removed from the East and North side of the cemetery.
- 8. Two crews of chain saw and brush pilers cleaned the area from the parking lot to the north boundary line of all lilacs.
- 9. It was estimated that one third of the cemetery is now clear of all Lilacs and brush
