How to find the Lone Pine Cemetery First you find Steptoe Butte near the town of Steptoe on Highway 195 between Colfax and Spokane WA. Then you proceed east towards the Idaho border to the town of Oaksdale. From Oaksdale you take the Oaksdale-Tekoa highway to Chase Road and go north to the Lone Pine Road. It is just a short distance east on the Lone Pine Road to Sieveke Road where you again turn north. Proceed to the top of the hill, about a 1/4 mile and the cemetery is on your left.



Below is a stone that has fallen over and been stood up next to it's base. There are several stones that need repairs and hopefully they are recoverable without great expense.



On the left is a row of stones that have withstood the rigors of time and the elements but could use a little cleaning and TLC.
