

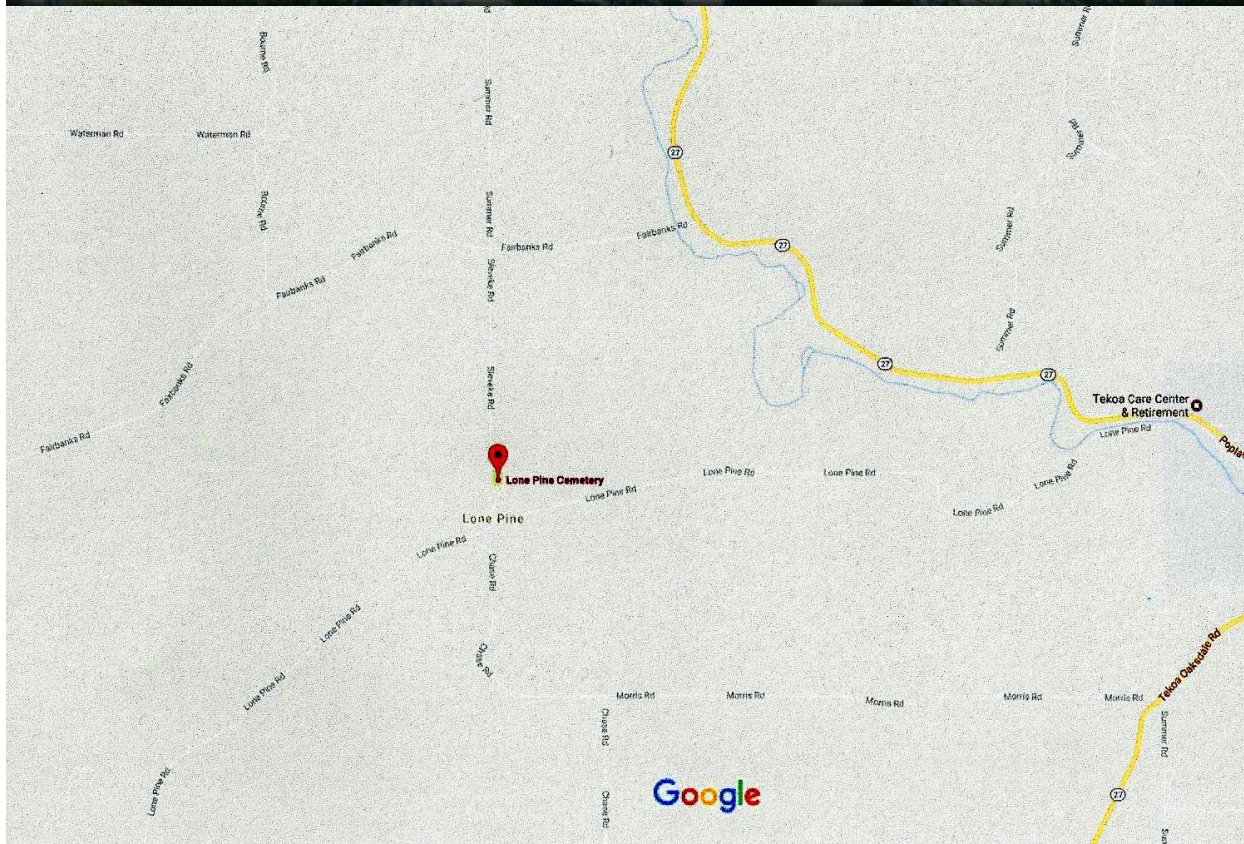

James H. Antle was born about 1871 in Arkansas as the first child of Oliver Antle and Sarah Elizabeth Simpson. He had seven siblings: Leroy D., Pearl May, Wade Hunter, Maude L. Caroline V. Cora L. and Mary B. He died in 1899 in Tekoa, Whitman, Washington.

**Mary Ann Smith Woodward—age 48**

Mary Ann Smith was born in 1852 in Woolwich, Canada. She died on 14 Nov 1900. When she was 24, she married Alba F Woodward.

**Willie Savitz—age 9 months**

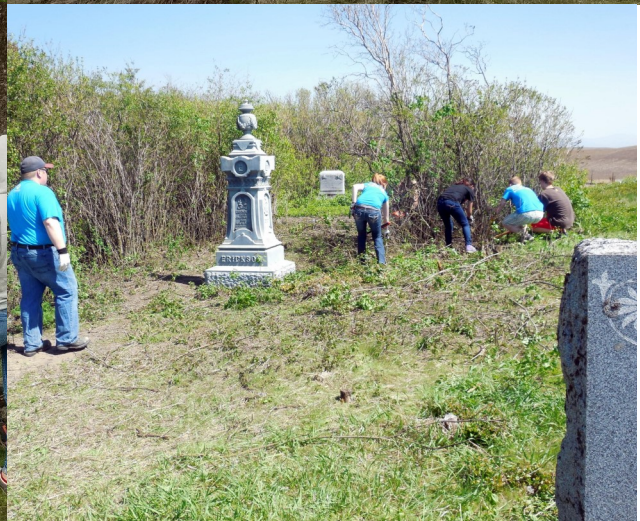
